

Poster upload and presentation

Posters will be made available online (for viewing and chat-style Q&A before and during the on-site meeting), although they will be presented at the on-site venue. This is to stimulate scientific discussion and exchange. Poster discussions (Q&A session) will be held at the on-site venue and will not be made available online. Poster presenters are asked to submit their poster data for online display according to the following instructions. Please note that the deadline for submission is early (until February 27). Please also print and bring your poster for on-site presentation.

Poster Specifications

Posters should be in English. The poster panel is 90 cm (width) × 210 cm (height from the floor). Pushpins for mounting your poster are provided by the Meeting Committee.

Submission of Poster Data for Online Publication

Submission period:

Friday, February 20, 2026 9:00 - Friday, February 27, 2026 24:00 (JST)

- Please provide your poster in PDF format so that it can be viewed online. The data size of your poster should be less than 2 M B if possible. The maximum size is 3 M B. Data larger than 3 M B cannot be submitted. We appreciate your cooperation in reducing the load on the system so that many people can participate in the meeting in a comfortable environment.
- The PDF file upload through the abstract submission system should be done between February 20 and 27. Please note that PDF files can only be viewed, not downloaded by participants.
- Please make sure the file is in PDF format. Other formats will not be accepted.
- During the online poster viewing period (March 10, 9:00 a.m. - March 15), participants can use the comment box on the abstract page of your poster posted on the web abstract portal (ORSAM portal) for questions and answers.
Please respond to questions in the comments section in a timely manner.
- Posters will be available in the Web Abstracts (ORSAM Portal) until March 31, after which they will be automatically deleted. If you wish to have your data deleted immediately after the Annual Meeting, please check the "I wish to have my data deleted" checkbox when uploading your poster.

Submission Method

(1) Please log in to the abstract submission system (ORSAM).

(2) On the menu screen, click "To revise the contents, click here." in the "Abstract Submission" section.

(3) At the bottom of the screen, there is a "Poster data (PDF) upload" field. Please make sure to upload the file in PDF format. The file name should be your abstract submission number (e.g. E00001.pdf).

(4) If you wish to delete your poster data after the Annual Meeting, please check the checkbox in the "Handling of Poster Data" box.

*Items other than "Upload Poster Data (PDF)" and "Handling of Poster Data" cannot be edited.

If you do not submit your poster data within the deadline, your poster data may not be published online in the ORSAM portal. Please be sure to submit your poster data within the deadline.

You may update your file as many times as you like within the deadline. Please note that no upload (revision) is allowed after the deadline.
